O come, let us adore Him, ...

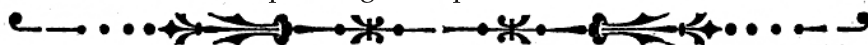

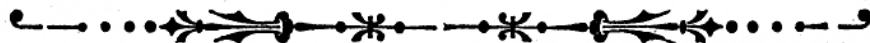
